The majority of respondents (54%) have a very high confidence level in completing the project within the deadline. This shows that employees are highly confident and committed toward successful project completion.

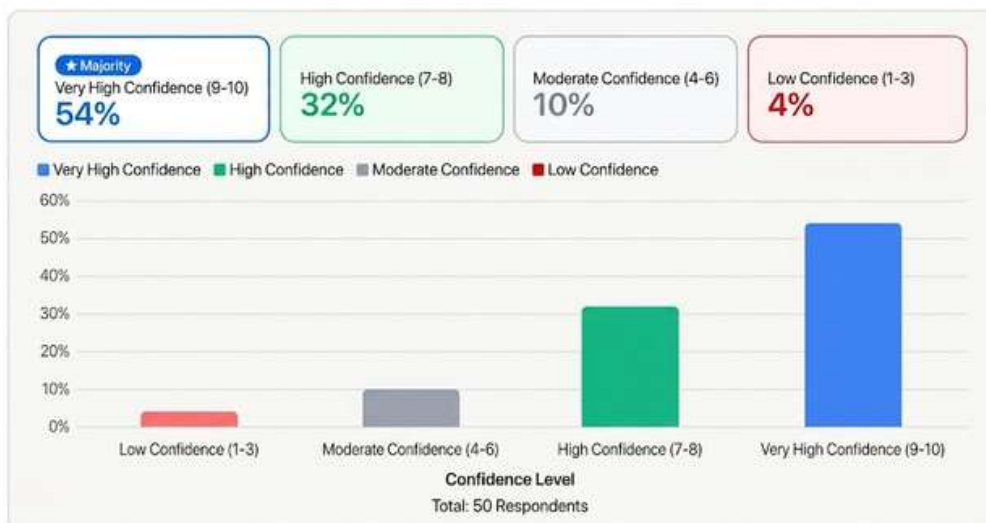

ANOVA

ANOVA was used to analyze whether employee opinions on HR policies differ across departments and work experience groups.

Result: The ANOVA results show a significant difference in employee opinions across groups ($p < 0.05$). This indicates that department and work experience significantly influence employee morale and organizational performance at NexPuzz Technologies Pvt Ltd.

FINDINGS

- The majority of respondents (42%) are below 25 years of age, and 56% of the respondents are female.
- The majority of respondents (68%) have completed UG education, while 40% belong to the Information Technology (IT) department.
- The largest share of respondents (32%) have 1–3 years and 4–6 years of work experience, and 36% earn between ₹15,000–₹30,000 per month.
- 72% of respondents strongly agree that HR policies are clearly communicated, and 52% agree that recruitment and selection processes are fair.
- 54% agree that employees receive adequate training and development opportunities, while 48% agree that performance appraisal systems are transparent.
- 48% strongly agree that compensation and benefits are satisfactory, and 44% agree that the organization provides equal growth opportunities.
- 40% strongly agree that work-life balance policies are effective, and 40% agree that HR policies motivate employees to perform better.



- 42% strongly agree that they have a positive relationship with management, and 46% strongly agree that the work environment is positive and supportive.
- 57% of respondents expressed a good opinion regarding the impact of HR policies on organizational performance, while only 2% expressed a bad opinion.
- 54% of respondents reported very high confidence in completing the project successfully within the deadline.

SUGGESTIONS
